Sean is a qualified ECA and still makes himself available for shifts on A&E ambulances. He qualified as an Accredited LSMS in 2011, having been a CRT trainer with EMAS, he is the Author of the current EMAS CRT training package. Sean is also currently the deputy Chair of the National Ambulance Security Group, which answers directly to QGARD and AACE (Association of Ambulance Chief Executives).

One of Sean's key priorities will be as a National lead and provide a voice within NAHS, for the NHS Ambulance Services. Sean recently completed the Diploma in Security Management through the Security Institute, is a member of Security and Chartered Management Institutes. He is also a Justice of the Peace in Northamptonshire. Prior to joining EMAS Sean served 23 years in the Merchant Navy and is a Holder of the South Atlantic, and Queens Diamond Jubilee Medals.

### Nigel Davies - Security Industry Authority



Nigel joined the SIA in January 2004, in preparation for the start of private security regulation.
