Malcolm Dawson BEM - University of Leeds

He has also being a consecutive two time Finalist (2012 and 2013) in the Security Manager of the year Category, at the Annual Security Excellence Awards in London.

On the 13th June 2015, Malcolm was recognised in the Queens 2015 Birthday Honours List and was awarded, by, Her Majesty The Queen, the British Empire Medal (BEM) for Services to Higher Education and Students. Malcolm is a proud member of the Security Institute as well as supporting AUCSO, the Association of Chief Security Officers, for over 20 years and he is the former Executive Chair of AUCSO for the Northern Region.

His last police posting was as the Head of Security at Parliament managing a complex armed and unarmed security operation mitigating the threat from international and domestic extremism, other unlawful behaviour and fixated people. Ed manages the regional investigation teams at the SIA, working with the industry to encourage individuals and businesses to comply with regulation. An increasing part of his and the SIA's focus is supporting UK enforcement and other agencies to reduce the harm caused to communities and industry reputation by serious and organised crime.

Mike is an experienced, senior information security practitioner of many years' standing and is well versed in the threat to organisational information assets. An active member of the Security Institute since 2008, Mike was voted onto the board of Directors in 2013 and given special responsibility for Cyber Research and Strategy.
