SPEAKERS

Les Allan - Heriot-Watt University



Les Allan, Director of SafeGuarding and Logistics Services at Heriot-Watt University in Edinburgh, is a former police officer with 30 years' experience in the tertiary education sector. He has been with Heriot-Watt since 2012 with a brief to restructure systems and modernise services. His remit takes in security, health and safety, fire safety, crisis management, transport and distribution, mail and portering. That remit is global and he is a frequent traveller between international campuses.

Les is regional chair of the Association of University Chief Security Officers (AUCSO) in Scotland. For eight years he was co-ordinating the Scottish Government's CHASTE Project, evaluating the security and safety systems in every university and college in Scotland. He has a background in creating strategic alliances and supporting large institutional mergers and campus re-locations. Les is a firm believer in succession planning and ensures that the structures he develops are sustainable by career development of young 'in house' talent.

Maxine Fraser - Retailers Against Crime



Maxine joined Retailers Against Crime (RAC) in 1998 and has been instrumental in expanding the membership from 47 stores in Scotland to over 1500 stores today throughout Scotland, Northern Ireland and North West England. Maxine has an extensive knowledge of retail crime and she and her team continue to identify individuals and organised crime groups who travel throughout the UK often resulting in preventing theft before it happens. In her current role, as well as overseeing the operation of RAC nationally, Maxine continues to work closely with police and crime partnerships to target retail criminals plus providing training in retail crime prevention and reduction. She is committed to changing the way that retail crime is perceived by the wider community and the younger generation by engaging with relevant agencies to raise awareness.

Michael White - G4S Secure Solutions



With twenty years industry experience and a background in operational management that includes critical national infrastructure sites, blue chip city clients and diplomatic clients across a range of industry sectors Mike moved into compliance and risk management five years ago initially as a consultant and latterly with G4S. His experience includes working in the Middle East and he regularly chairs and presents at conferences both in the UK and in Europe.
